- Create a poster showcasing a woman of your choice who has helped change the world.
- Write 3-5 questions you'd ask Florence Nightingale, Amelia Earhart or Rosa Parks.
- Write 5 sentences about how you'd like to change the world.
- Read a fact file about a significant woman in history - can you choose 2/3 words which are new and interest you? Can you find out their meaning with an adult?

Wider Curriculum

- Create a portrait of a significant woman in history, this could be one which we're learning about or someone else.

- Identify countries where significant women were born on a world map.
- Research Mary Annings - can you create a fossil?
