

# Significant Individuals - Explorers

Homework: choose up to 3 pieces of work to complete this half term, this is not an exhaustive list - you may choose to do something different. Any work should be handed in to your class teacher by **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December**.

## English (reading/writing)

- Imagine you're an explorer, write about a special journey you would take. What would you discover? Draw a picture and write about your adventure.
- Choose either Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong or another explorer of your choice and write 3 facts about their exploration.
- Read a short story about an explorer.
- Imagine you are Christopher Columbus or Neil Armstrong and create a diary entry describing your feelings and experiences on the day you made your important discovery.
- Read a story or information text about an explorer whilst reading find 3-5 new words you've discovered or find interesting.

## Wider Curriculum

- Create a map showing the journey of Christopher Columbus - label the map with names of places and symbols.
- Create a timeline of events in Christopher Columbus or Neil Armstrong's life - draw simple pictures or write captions on a timeline.
- Design or make a ship or spaceship which an explorer might use - label the parts and write a sentence explaining any special features.
- Make a secret map of a pretend new land/planet you've discovered. Draw landmarks, animals, and anything else you may find there.
- Create a mini model of your new land/planet in a shoebox
