


# The Water Cycle

Homework: choose up to 3 pieces of work to complete this half term, this is not an exhaustive list - you may choose to do something different. Any work should be handed in to your class teacher by the last day of term.

## English (reading/writing)

- Write a poem that involves a body of water.
- Write your own story that includes a river.
- Find out about a famous river e.g. the river Nile and write some facts about it.
- Write a short news report about how pollution is affecting our water.
- Find out how echoes are created and write facts about this.
- If possible, visit a local body of water and write a description of what you can see.
- Read a book by Roald Dahl and write a review about it.

## Wider Curriculum

- Create a representation of a river - this can be however you like e.g. in Lego, on Minecraft or on paper!
- Find out how water evaporates and see if you can evaporate water at home.
- Choose a selection of water-safe objects and see which ones sink or float.
- Use either devices or books to find out key facts about the Sikh religion.
- Find out where water comes from.
- Create a poster which explains the water cycle.
- Practice using column addition to add 2 two-digit numbers.
