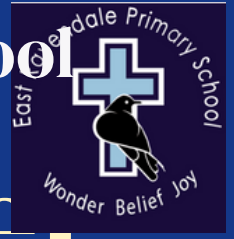

Wednesday 18th March - Year3 / 4 football tournament - details to follow

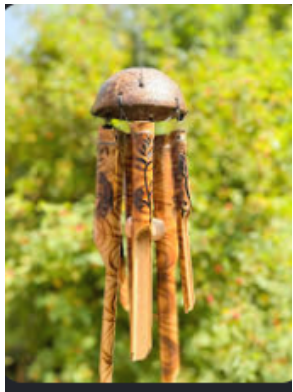
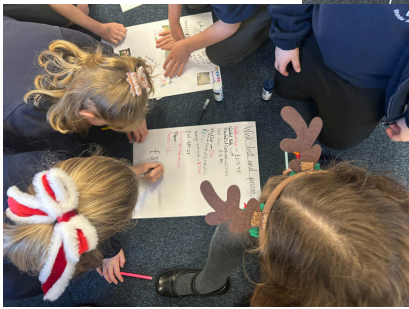
