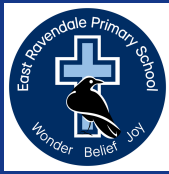

It is open to both boys and girls, and we would love to welcome some new members!

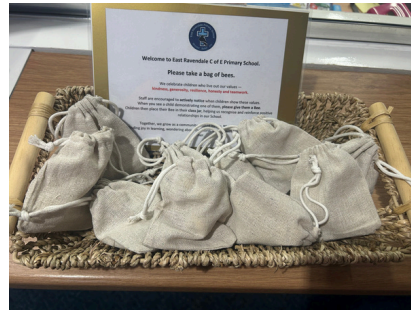


School Uniform Reminder
