English

- Write a diary entry from the point of view of a *Climate Hero* who is trying to protect the Earth.
- Write a persuasive letter to the school, community, or local council explaining **one change** they should make to help the environment.
- Create a mini glossary of **8–10 climate-related words** (e.g. *pollution, recycle, renewable, drought, habitat*).
- Write a short newspaper article imagining what Earth might be like in **20 years** if we *do* or *do not* take care of the planet.
- Write a poem about climate change or nature.
- Watch part of a film or read a book linked to nature or climate (e.g. *The Lorax*) and write a short review.

Other Subjects

- Carry out a simple experiment to explore heat and temperature, such as placing one thermometer in sunlight and one in shade (or near a window). Write what you notice!
- Create a tally chart of how energy is used at home in one day (lights on, devices charging, TV use).
- Choose one place affected by climate change (e.g. Arctic, rainforest, island).
- Design a poster showing the effects of climate change or how to protect the planet.
- Create a short digital presentation (slides or poster) explaining **three ways** to help reduce climate change.
